

Trees for LAUSD

Planet Green has partnered with TreePeople to reward qualified Los Angeles Unified School District campuses with a tree planting - including 10 free trees - managed by students, parents and teachers.

Each qualified public school in the Los Angeles Unified School District that recycles 1,500 qualified inkjet cartridges with Planet Green will receive free Campus Forestry training from TreePeople, resulting in a community-run tree planting at their school.

This partnership rewards qualified schools in the following ways:

- Through Planet Green's inkjet, laser cartridge and cell phone recycling program every school will be able to raise funds for their individualized needs (On average, 1,500 inkjet cartridges will earn a school \$3,700.00);
- The partnership will educate Los Angeles youth about the importance of recycling and tree plantings;
- Increasing beauty and environmental health for Los Angeles Unified School District campuses through qualified tree plantings;
- Combined, our efforts will contribute to the mission of Mayor Antonio Villaraigosa's Million Trees LA Initiative.
